

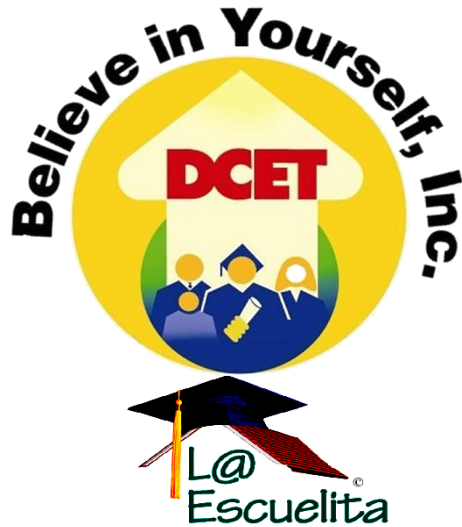

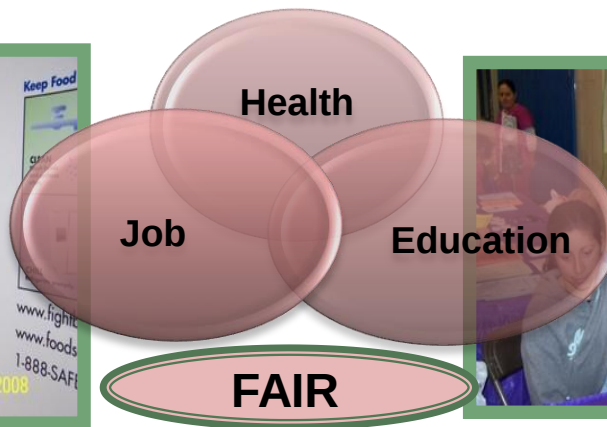

Historical significance for USA



The Mexicans won a victory that kept Napoleon III from supplying the Confederate rebels for another year, this allowed USA to build the greatest army ever seen.

This grand army smashed the Confederates at Gettysburg just 14 months after the Battle of Civil War.

Some historians believe that it is possible the Civil War may have had a different outcome if the French had been able to join the Confederate army as planned.

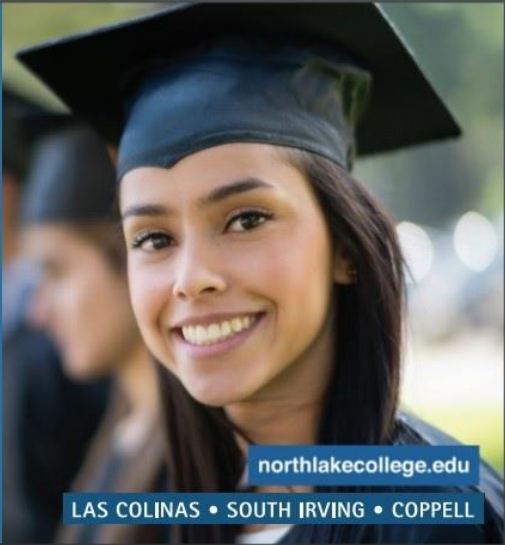

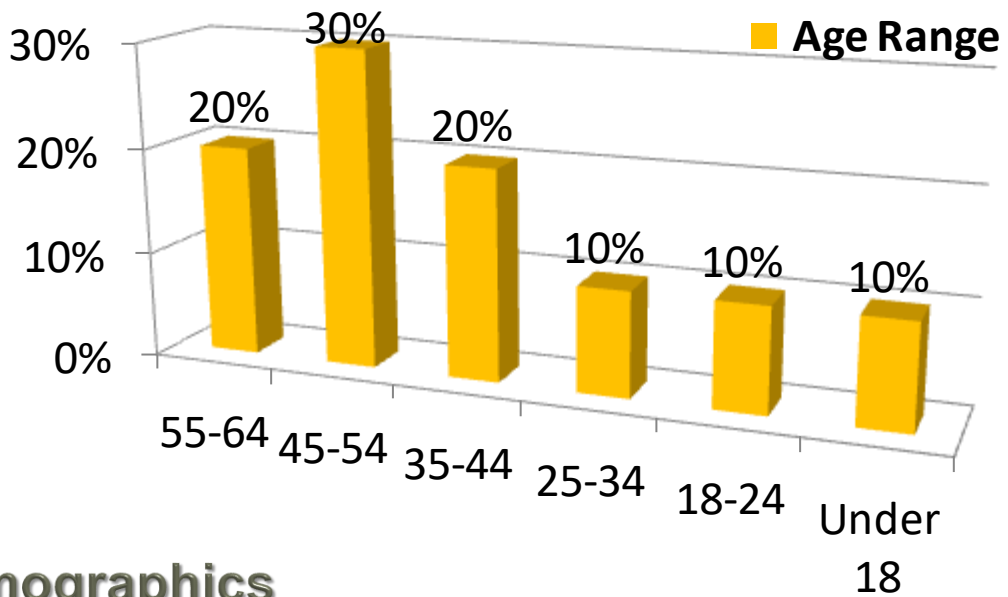

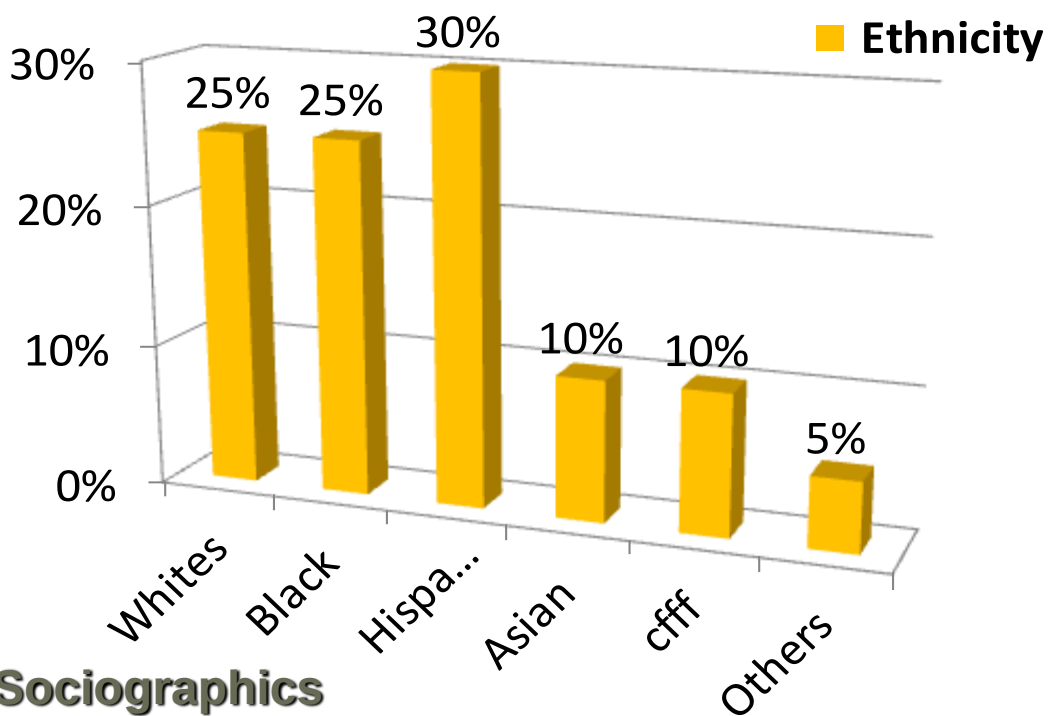

Need to make appointment: 214.266.1232

Requirements:

- At least 35 years of age
- Have not received a mammogram in the last 12 months.
- Proof that you reside in Dallas County
 - ◊ Picture ID (work or government issued)
 - ◊ Utility bill with your name and address (gas, electric, telephone, water)
 - ◊ If you are covered by insurance (Private, Medicaid, Medicare) we ask that you call the number listed.

In order to better serve you we ask that if you have physical limitations or questions regarding mammograms that you contact us at 214.266.1232.

Factors that may increase your risk of breast cancer

- If you are over the age of 35
- If you have had breast cancer in the past
- If your mother, sister or daughter have had breast cancer
- If you have more than one alcoholic beverage per day
- If you have taken birth control pills for more than five years
- If you have never had children

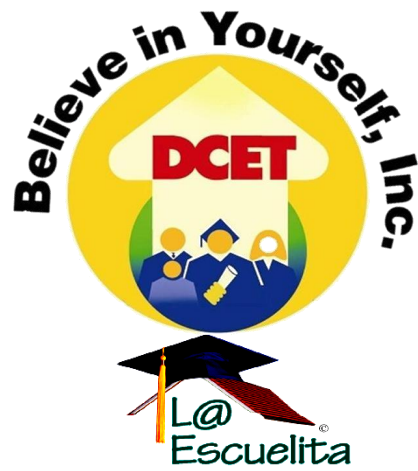
