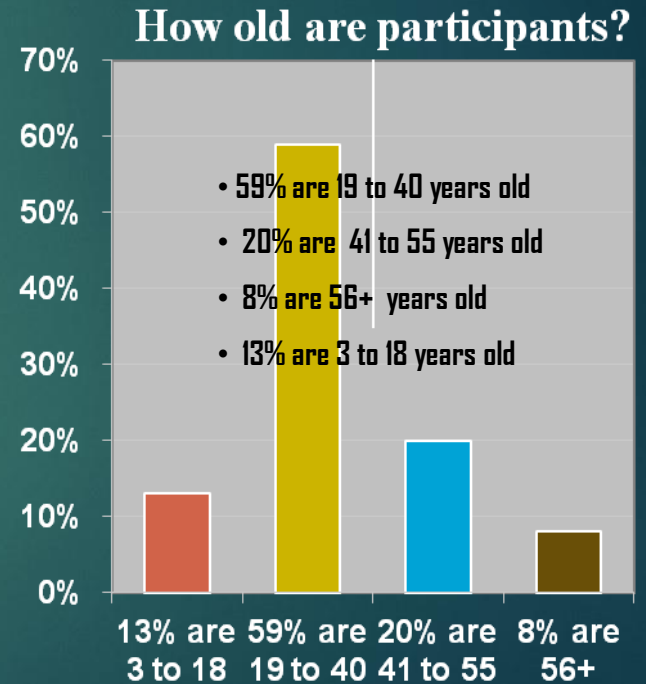

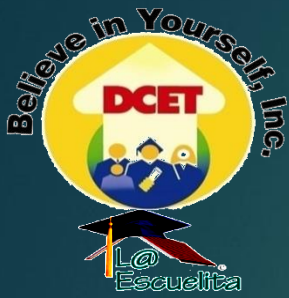


DCET is Multigenerational
